



Executive Order

No. 11, Series of 2020

AN ORDER PLACING THE ENTIRE MUNICIPALITY OF ALBUERA IN GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE (GCQ) AND PROVIDING FOR GUIDELINES AS PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES AGAINST COVID-19.

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte pronounced and classified that the Province of Leyte be under General Community Quarantine starting July 1, 2020 to July 15, 2020;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of the Philippines provides that every Local Government Unit is mandated to ensure and promote health and safety of its inhabitants within the respective territorial jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, there is a need to continue and provide appropriate guidelines in order to mitigate the spread of Covid-19 in the Municipality of Albuera;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SIXTO B. DELA VICTORIA, Municipal Mayor of the Municipality of Albuera, Leyte, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, in the interest of public health and safety, do hereby order the following:

SECTION 1. DECLARATION OF GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE. The Municipality of Albuera shall be placed under General Community Quarantine starting July 1, 2020 and continue until 11:59 o'clock in the evening of July 15, 2020 and may be shortened or extended depending on the recommendation of the Municipal Inter-Agency Task Force for the Covid-19 disease.

SECTION 2. GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. All persons are mandated to wear face masks at all time in public pursuant to Ordinance No. 2020-05.
2. Observe Social Distancing and regular hand washing to effectively protect and lessen the transmission of Covid-19.
3. The movement of all persons in this municipality shall be limited to accessing essential goods and services, and for work in the offices or industries permitted to operate. Movement for leisure purposes is not allowed at all times.
4. Any person below twenty-one (21) years old, those who are sixty (60) years old and above, those with immunodeficiency, comorbidities, or other health risk, and pregnant women, including any person who resides with the aforementioned, shall be required to remain in their residences at all times, except when indispensable under the circumstances for obtaining essential goods and services or for work in permitted industries and offices.
5. Curfew to all residents from 9:00 o'clock in the evening until 4:00 o'clock in the morning of the following day is still in effect except for workers, frontliners, healthcare and emergency personnel, uniform men and government officials in exercise of their official functions, pursuant to Municipal Ordinance No. 2020-06
6. Liquor drinking session in public is strictly prohibited and Liquor Ban will be implemented.
7. Acts of discrimination inflicted upon healthcare workers, repatriated OFWs and non-OFWs, Covid-19 cases, whether PUMs or PUIs are denounced in the strongest terms. Acts in furtherance of the same such as, but not limited to, coercion, libel, slanders,

physical injuries and the dishonour of contractual obligations such as contracts of lease or employment, shall be dealt with accordingly, pursuant to Municipal Ordinance No. 2020-03.

SECTION 3. PROTOCOLS FOR REPATRIATES, BALIK PROBINSYA & LOCALLY STRANDED INDIVIDUALS COMING BACK TO ALBUERA. The policies and principles mandated under Executive Order No. 10, dated June 15, 2020 shall remain in force and effect but subject to the following amendments stated herein, to wit;

1. Balik Probinsya, Returning Overseas Filipinos-Repatriates, Locally Stranded Individuals and returnees who stayed more than one (1) day from Positive Covid-19 areas within thirty (30) days who shows up at the Municipal Check Points shall be held thereat for validation from the Barangay Officials after which the same will be turned over to the Barangay for the mandated 14 days Quarantine Protocol once confirmed. ***Residents who stayed more than one (1) day from Positive Covid-19 areas within thirty (30) days will undergo the mandated 14 days Quarantine Protocol from their respective Barangay Isolation centers.***
3. Non-coordinated arrival in Albuera should be reported right away and no instance be ***allowed*** to go directly to their respective homes, rather submit to their respective BHERT/Barangay Captain and undergo the mandated 14 days Quarantine Protocol to avoid being penalized under existing laws and regulations.
7. ***COVID 19 testing using RT PCR Test or Rapid test shall be done to those quarantined:***
 1. ***Symptomatic individuals***
 2. ***Exposed patient to Covid19 Positive patients***
8. ***A Certificate of Completion shall be issued by the barangay captain on the 15th day of the mandated 14 days Quarantine Protocol if no signs and symptoms of COVID 19 arise and seven (7) days after, a Certificate of Quarantine will be issued by the Municipal Health Office.***

SECTION 4. INTERZONAL AND INTRAZONAL MOVEMENT -

1. The entry of persons coming from places with confirmed COVID-19 local/community transmission within thirty (30) days is strictly prohibited.
2. Residents coming from places with confirmed COVID-19 local/community transmission within thirty (30) days shall undergo the mandated 14 days Quarantine Protocol in their respective barangay isolation areas upon return.
3. Residents-Workers who works in places with confirmed COVID-19 cases or with local/community transmission within thirty (30) days shall stay at their respective barangay isolation areas upon return and remain thereat until such time they resume and go back to their work or proceed with the mandated 14 days Quarantine and no time shall they be allowed to stay in their residence nor have personal contact with anybody in the community.
4. Non-residents of this municipality without any valid reasons including, but not limited to, passer bys, working, livelihood, medical and health reasons, purchase of necessary food and house supplies are also restricted.
5. Non-residents of this municipality who are Authorized Persons Outside Residence (APOR) pursuant to Executive Order No. 10, dated June 15, 2020 and as mandated by the regulations of the National Government, shall be allowed entry subject to the provisions of Section 5.
6. The unhampered movement and travel of all cargoes for food and essentials goods shall be observed subject to the provisions of Section 5 and provided that only a maximum of five (5) personnel may operate cargo and delivery vehicles, with or without load. NO PERSONAL CONTACT POLICY MUST BE OBSERVED AT ALL TIMES WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY.

SECTION 5. ESTABLISHMENT OF CHECK-POINT/BORDER CONTROL. In order to monitor the entry of all returnees, to prevent the spread of Covid-19 and to ensure that Sections 3 and 4 are strictly enforced, check-points/border control will be established at the municipal borders manned by the members of the Albuera PNP, the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP), the Municipal Health Office (MHO), the Municipal Disaster and Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO), the Bureau of Fire Protection, Barangay officials/volunteer and from the Civic Organizations: Kasama Inc. and Guardians.

1. The following Protocols will be observed at Checkpoints:
 - a. All persons entering the check point shall wear face mask, observe social distancing and shall be subjected to thermal scanning;
 - b. All vehicles, private and public, and delivery trucks shall be subjected for inspection by the members of the PNP and monitoring; and
 - c. All passengers bound for Albuera shall be subjected to inquiry for monitoring purposes.
2. Documents required upon entry at Checkpoints:
 - a. Certification of being non-PUM/PUI Valid for 1 week from the date of issuance (for APOR)
 - b. Certification of being non-PUM/PUI Valid for 1 day from the date of issuance (for non-residence not belonging to APOR)
 - c. Identification Card
 - d. Proof of Residency (for residents) shall be presented upon entry;
 - e. Recent Certificate of Employment (for workers)
 - f. Business Registration (for Business operators in Albuera)
 - g. Quick Response (QR) Code
 - h. Delivery Vehicles, including its driver and helpers shall:
 1. Delivery receipts
 2. Health cards
 - Company Documents

SECTION 6. REGULATIONS ON BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS – In accordance with the Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines (with amendments as of 25 June 2020) issued by the IATF-MEID, business establishments shall be allowed to operate except the following:

1. Gym/Fitness studios and sports facilities;
2. Amusements, Betting, and Gaming establishments;
3. Bars and Pub houses;
4. Kids Playhouse and like establishments; and
5. Travel agencies and tourism industries.

Hotels and similar establishments shall be allowed to operate but only to accommodate the following:

1. Guest having long-term bookings;
2. Distressed Overseas Filipino Workers (OFWs) and Stranded Filipinos or Foreign nationals;
3. Repatriated OFWs in compliance with approved quarantine protocols;
4. Non-OFWs who may be required to undergo mandatory facility-based quarantine;
5. Healthcare workers and other front liners.

Restaurants, snacks, refreshment stores, and similar establishments shall operate and allow its patrons and customers to dine in on a twenty five percent (25%) capacity.

Barbershops, parlors, salons and other personal care establishments, Ukay-Ukay, Ready to Wear (RTW) stores and similar establishments shall be allowed to operate provided that social distancing, wearing of face masks, and disinfection of equipment after use on each customer, are strictly implemented. There shall be no over-crowding inside said establishments, and queuing or lining up outside of these establishment shall strictly follow protocols of social distancing and wearing of face masks, provided, that those persons below twenty-one (21) years old, and also

those sixty-one (61) years old and above, shall not be allowed to enter, except when indispensable under the circumstances for obtaining essential goods, and services, or for work.

Violation of the above mandates shall make the owners and operators of the business establishments liable to criminal prosecution, as well as the immediate closure of their establishments

SECTION 7. REGULATION ON CERTAIN ACTIVITIES – The following are the guidelines on certain activities:

1. Entertainment-related, Mass gatherings, theaters, cinemas, concerts, fiestas, festivals, carnivals, conventions, shows, trade shows, workshops, retreats, and political gatherings are strictly prohibited.
2. Religious gatherings of all religious denominations are discouraged, but shall be allowed under the following conditions:
 - a. That the attendees shall not exceed one-half (1/2) capacity of the venue,
 - b. That strict social distancing of two meters distance between attendees be observed
 - c. That wearing of face mask and other minimum health standards are observed.
 - d. That regular disinfection of facilities will be done.
 - e. Allow entry of LGU personnel to conduct random checking if protocols are observed.
 - f. That those exhibiting flu-like symptoms/s be denied admittance to the same.
3. Individuals' outdoor exercises such as outdoor walks, jogging, running, biking, tennis, practical or sports shooting, badminton, and other non-contact sports shall be allowed, provided that the main health standards and precautions such as wearing of face masks, and the maintenance of social distancing protocols are observed. Basketball, football, frisbee, volleyball, swimming, and other contact sports shall continue to be prohibited

SECTION 8. ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTY. The Albuera Police Office and other law enforcement agencies are tasked to implement this EO and ensure that the same are properly observed. Any person caught violating the provisions of this and previous executive orders issued in relation to the community quarantine, and other measures against Covid-19, shall be prosecuted under existing and pertinent laws.

SECTION 9. EFFECTIVITY. Previous executive orders or provisions thereof, which are inconsistent with this Executive Order, are deemed amended and superseded. This Executive Order shall take effect on July 1, 2020, and shall remain in force and effect while the General Community Quarantine subsists, or unless rendered ineffective in writing by the Mayor.
